

Laura Jade is an Australian illumination artist and interaction designer who creates immersive public artworks that fuse the multidisciplinary fields of art, biology, illumination design, neuroscience and BCI (brain-computer interface) technology.

Laura has a multidisciplinary background, holding a Masters in Illumination Design from the University of Technology Sydney, a degree in Fine Art and further studies in biology, science communication, curation and museum studies. Laura's academic research, New Ways of Knowing Ourselves. BCI Facilitating Artistic Exploration of Our Biology has been included as a chapter in book Brain Art: Brain-Computer Interfaces for Artistic Expression, published by Springer 2019.

Laura has created large scale installation artworks for clients such as Elle, MG and Samsung as well as Australian festivals including Vivid, Curiocity, BEAMS, Woodford Follk Festival and Sydney Science Festival. She has exhibited at major institutions across Australia, including the Museum of Contemporary Art, The Powerhouse Museum, the Australian Museum, the S.A Natural History Museum and the National Archives in Canberra. Internationally, her work has been exhibited in Iceland, Netherlands, Colombia, India, Canary Islands, UK, Croatia, Greece, Germany and New Zealand.

BRAINLIGHT

Public interactive light sculpture

Brainlight is an interactive illuminated brain sculpture developed in collaboration with a neuroscientist and software developer. It lights up in response to live brain data received from an EEG headset giving the viewer a unique bio-feedback experience of their mind. Experienced by over 30,000 people nationally and internationally since it was created in 2015.
